

Meeting of the Town Board – July 7, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chair, Heidi Kroening. Others present were Abe Mach and Pete Steen; Treasurer, Connie Anderson and Clerk, Nancy Hedin.

The secretary's report was read and approved.

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Pam Juhl was present to discuss a drainage issue on her road. Mach stated that he had gone out and looked at it. Discussion followed. The culvert is open from Rush Lake to Sturgeon Lake, but because Rush Lake is high, it is causing the pooling in her yard. In the front of her yard, possibly building up the yard with topsoil may stop some of the water, but the township does not place culverts in driveways for residents. The board will look into the water shed matter further.

Phil White was present. He brought up the idea of a holiday party. He stated that he would be willing to work on this when the time gets closer.

Kroening gave the Fire District update.

Strandlie gave the Planning Commission update. He asked the board to review the changes that the Planning Commission has made to the zoning ordinance on Portable Storage Containers and Temporary Structures. The board will review the changes and get back to the Planning Commission by August for recommendations.

Kroening followed up on the Forest Line Road. The township has not put any money or done any maintenance on this road so therefore it is not a township road.

Kroening discussed job descriptions.

Kroening stated that the township does not need to set aside money at the Annual Meeting for donations.

The board reviewed the liquor license for Docs Sports Bar and the Moose Lake Golf Club.

Motion was made by Mach, second by Steen to approve the liquor license for Docs Sports Bar and the Moose Lake Golf Club. Motion passed.

Kroening discussed with the board the "Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings" bill.

Buetow gave the road update.

Motion was made by Mach, second by Steen for the purchase of six tires for the grader from Glen's Tire. Motion passed.

Schumann gave the zoning update.

Ben Johnson was present to discuss his blight notice and having a septic system installed.

Motion was made by Steen, second by Mach to approve the contract with Moose Tracks for the cleaning of the township hall. Motion passed.

Motion was made by Mach, second by Kroening to have personal claims to Connie Anderson the Monday before the meeting. Motion passed.

The claims were reviewed.

Motion was made by Steen, second by Mach to approve claims 10,566-10,614 in the total of \$93,439.56.

Motion was made to adjourn.
