

This picture shows water standing  
5 feet deep along Hwy 35 after  
it goes through the outlet leaving  
Sturgeon lake. Highway 35 was  
constructed in the mid 60 when  
Sturgeon was low. Highway 35 blocks  
the natural flow of water  
toward the Willow River.



This is a picture of a survey done  
in 1977. It shows the depth of  
the property being 230 feet to  
the waters edge. It also has  
a note that shows the waters  
edge being approximately 100 feet  
deeper in 1930. This property  
is totally under water now.
