WINDEMERE TOWNSHIP <u>SPECIAL PROVISIONS</u> FOR INSTALLATION OF UTILITIES OR UNDERGROUND CONSTRUCTION AND STREET EXCAVATION WITHIN PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY

Township Engineer

- 1. No work under this application shall be started until the permit application is reviewed, approved and the permit is issued. Permittee shall keep a copy of this permit on the job site at all times.
- 2. Permittee agrees to conduct all work in accordance with Windemere Township Ordinances, including but not limited to the Right-of-Way Management Ordinance, Township specifications, and all applicable laws and standards
- 3. Applicant shall be responsible for notifying Pine County Sheriff, Fire, emergency services and Township Clerk at least 24 hours in advance prior to planned street closures or in the event of an emergency closure.
- 4. Where work on the traveled roadway is necessary, traffic must be protected and all traffic control devices and road closures shall be made in accordance with the most current edition of the Minnesota Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MnMUTCD) and Field manual.
- 5. Excavations shall be cribbed as necessary depending on type of soil encountered in order to prevent cave-ins.
 - No undermining of streets, curbs, bituminous trails, and/or sidewalks (except for boring) will be allowed.
 - b. When possible, all excavation and holes shall be a minimum of 6 feet from the edge of a road shoulder or the back of curb unless written justification is provided.
- 6. Underground construction must be so constructed as not to harm or unnecessarily destroy the root growth of adjacent or ornamental trees.
- 7. Turf restoration shall mean that existing sodded areas will be sodded and that all other areas can be seeded. It is the permit holder's responsibility to maintain the sod/seed. 4" of topsoil is required below new seed or sod.
- 8. No trenching across surfaced roadways shall be permitted unless it can be demonstrated to the Township Engineer that no reasonable alternative exists.
- 9. All back-fill within the road core must be placed in 6-inch layers and thoroughly tamped, unless otherwise directed and material must be flush and even with the road surface when finally in place. No rock, unstable soil, or bituminous material shall be returned to a back-filled trench.
- 10. Finished surface, base, and sub-base, of road after excavation and back-fill, shall be at least equal in stability to finished surface, base, and sub-base prior to excavation. A minimum 6" Class 5 aggregate base material shall be placed at the upper surface of the excavated trench unless otherwise directed or required by the Township Engineer through the plan review process.
- 11. Bituminous and gravel surfaces shall be replaced according to Township specifications, which shall be provided by the Township Engineer at the time of permit review.

- 12. If settlement occurs or excavation caves-in within one year from completion date, it shall be restored to its original condition by the Applicant/holder of this permit.
- 13. No pole anchors, anchors, braces, or other construction shall be placed on roadway shoulder except by special authorization.
- 14. No driving onto a highway from the ditch, or driving on shoulders, shall be authorized except when noted in application for permit.
- Streets may not be closed to traffic unless expressly authorized by the permit and necessary notifications have 15. been made.
- 16. No lugs shall be used on the tires of equipment traversing roadways, which will damage the road surface.
- Roadside and/or site shall be cleaned up after work is completed. Any disturbed areas will be restored to 17. existing conditions or better.
- Within 24 hours, and during normal working hours, (no permits for any type of excavation on public property 18. will be issued for construction on Saturday, Sunday or legal holidays, except for emergency repairs) the permit holder shall notify the Town Clerk that such work has been completed and is ready for final inspection. The Completion Notification form found on the Township's website shall be used to request final inspection of any work site.
- 19. All culverts shall be corrugated metal with aprons unless waived by the Township.
- No street excavation shall be allowed between November 15th and May 15th, except for emergencies. 20.
- 21. Permittee agrees to promptly pay any additional Township costs incurred (over and above the initial permit fees) should issues arise during the performance of the work. Permittee further acknowledges and agrees that Windemere Township shall draw on the Performance Bond (or other financial security) if charges are not promptly paid.
